About Business Communication Program

The Business Communication Program (BC), Faculty of Liberal Arts, Thammasat University, is a dynamic undergraduate international program. We are now looking for a qualified Japanese instructor with an academic-oriented mind, energy, and willingness to be part of our teaching staff. The initial contract is one year, with renewal upon evaluation. Research assistance and promotion to assistant, associate, and full professor are highly prized and supported.

Qualifications

Those who are interested in this position must possess the following qualifications:

1. A native Japanese speaker, in good health, and under the age of 50.
2. A graduate degree (master's or doctoral) in Business Japanese, Teaching Japanese as a Foreign Language or business-related fields.
3. With work experience in a business area or teaching at a university level or an applicant with experience in both will receive special consideration.
4. Proficient in English for oral communication and writing areas will be highly desired. A proof of English proficiency is preferred.

Benefits

1. Salary: negotiable rate depending on experience and possessing a graduate degree, starts at 27,130 baht plus Housing benefit 8,000 baht per month
2. Health insurance (partial self-payment required)
3. Extra payment for extra teaching hours (1,500 baht/ hour). However, this is not guaranteed. It depends on the lecturer's request and is subject to the program committee's decision.

First-stage: Screening of an applicant's qualifications based on relevant documents. Any qualified applicant will be shortlisted for an interview and a teaching demonstration.

Second-stage: Interview, 30-minute teaching demonstration (available online)
